



WHEREAS, Sec. 33 of RA 4566, otherwise known as the Contractors' License Law, expressly provides that it is unlawful for two or more contractors to jointly submit a bid/negotiate without first having secured an additional license for acting in the capacity of a joint vendor or any such combination thereof;

WHEREAS, Sec. 19.2 of PD 149 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of RA 4566, provides that a contractor who wishes to act as a joint vendor, bidder or consortium licensee for it to be legally authorized to submit a bid/negotiate as the case may be;

WHEREAS, despite reminders from PCAB, project owners continue to allow a joint venture/consortium to participate in bidding/negotiations without requiring the

contractor to be a duly licensed contractor as required by the law.

WHEREAS, the contractor who is a joint vendor/bidder/consortium licensee is not a contractor as defined in the law and is not a contractor as defined in the law.

This resolution shall take effect fifteen (15) days from publication in the official gazette of the Philippines.




