ENDORSING THE AMENDMENTS TO CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF THE IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS OF R.A. 4566 (THE CONTRACTOR'S LICENSE LAW) FOR THE APPROVAL OF THE PRESIDENT OF THE PHILIPPINES PURSUANT TO THE PHILIPPINE CONTRACTORS ACCREDITATION BOARD (PCAB) RESOLUTION NO.151, SERIES OF 2015

WHEREAS, the Construction Industry Authority of the Philippines (CIAP), under Section 2 (a) of PD 1746 is tasked to promote, accelerate and regulate the growth and development of the construction industry in conformity with national goals;

WHEREAS, among the powers of CIAP are: to evolve an overall strategy and exercise centralized authority for the optimum development of the construction industry; to establish criteria for the classification and categorization of contractors which accurately reflect their contracting capacity and performance capability to enforce

relevant and reasonable rules and requirements, as well as implement practicable and efficient procedures for prequalification of public projects; and to perform such other functions necessary to achieve its objectives;

WHEREAS, the same law provides that CIAP shall exercise jurisdiction over its implementing arms to include Philippine Contractors Accreditation Board (PCAB) which


